



Over 100 People Enjoy Second Annual Liberal Judaism Parenting Day

On Sunday 4th November, 2007, Liberal Judaism held a second successful annual Parenting Day at the Liberal Jewish Synagogue in St John's Wood. The event was run by a team of Liberal Judaism staff, including rabbis, educators and LJY-Netzer youth movement leaders.

Over 100 parents and children took part in a wide range of seminars and workshops while the children enjoyed programmes devised by LJY-Netzer. Sessions ranged from Big Jewish Decisions, Family Traditions and Talking to Your Children about Israel to Challah Making, Music and Art and Craft workshops.

A parent who participated in the day commented, saying it was "Excellent, well organized, very thought-provoking , fun –packed , never a dull moment, varied and well thought out, so much to do ...so little time".

Rabbi Danny Rich, Chief Executive of Liberal Judaism, said: "I'm delighted that the Liberal Judaism Parenting Day has now become an annual event and that Liberal Judaism continues to inspire families in this way".
